



Scholarships for International Students
The Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation
(International Program) Academic Year 2020

1. Introduction

The College of Innovation Thammasat University (CITU), Thailand was established in 1991 as an interdisciplinary academic institution. The balanced curriculum between the science & technology blended with social science and humanities aspects were carefully crafted to fit the needs of the society in an international arena.

The College of Innovation has a scholarship program for international students to study towards the Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation (International Program). The Service Innovation Program has been established in response to service trends and concepts for the public, private as well as nonprofit sectors. It has been designed to provide graduates with an international perspective on service delivery and service design as well as enhance their interpersonal communication, teamwork and leadership capacities.

2. Scholarship Coverage

As part of efforts to internationalize our teaching and learning environment, the College provides 10 scholarships which covers tuition fees and other related fees during the four-year study period as follows.

1. Tuition fees
2. University fees and College fees
3. Housing expenses might be granted based on the College's Scholarship Committee. Airfare and allowance are not included in the scholarship. They are under the responsibility of the student.

3. Eligibility of Scholarship Candidates

To be eligible for scholarships, an applicant must:

1. Be a successful candidate for studying towards the Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation (International Program)
2. Not be of Thai nationality
3. Have a minimum high school GPA at 3.00

4. A minimum score from one of the following English Proficiency Tests.

TOEFL (PBT/ITP)	500
TOEFL (CBT)	173
TOEFL (IBT)	61
IELTS	6.0
TU-GET	500
TU-GET (CBT)	61

The score must not be more than two years old.

4. Admission Schedule

Applicants must apply to the Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation (International Program) for an Academic Year 2020 (B.E. 2563). Admission schedule is as follows.


5. Scholarship Period

The scholarship is for a period of 4 years effective from August 2020 to July 2024.

6. Terms & Conditions for Scholarship

1. Applicants who are awarded the scholarships will be required to work as student assistants for 40 hours per semester to assist the College in meeting its overall mandate. Specific duties and responsibilities will be assigned by Program Directors/ or CITU administrators.
2. Applicants who are awarded the scholarships must maintain the average GPA at 3.00 each academic year and complete their studies by July 2024. In the case of not achieving the required GPA, the College reserves the right to consider termination of the scholarships.
3. In the case of leaving the program at the middle of study, applicants who are awarded the scholarships must refund all tuition fees and expenses covered by CITU.
